REV. DR. PRINGLE'S SPEECH STIRS GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Cabinet Minister Politicians Attacked Unmeasured Terms.

CONDITION OF THE YUKON.

He Accuses the Assembly of Having Left Him Naked to His Enemies.

A. Sorrowful Condition of Public Life Depicted by the Rev. Doctor, Who Professes Himself Ready to Defend Any Label Suits—Rev. Mr. Rochester Declines Appointment as Home Mission Superintendent in Alberta—Buildings for Foreign Missions—No Peace Resolution—Close of the Assembly.

(Special Despatch to The Globe.)

Hamilton, June 10.—The skirts of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church were dragged through the mire of politics to-day in a sensational speech by Rev. Dr. John Pringle, formerly of the Yukon, and now of Sydney, N.S., who in his desire to expose the evils of political life attacked the Government and the characters of public men in terms that fairly made the fathers and brethren gasp. Dr. Pringle took his text from the pages of the Cassels Commission report, and hinged thereon a number of startling statements relating to the prevalence of vice in the Yukon, and reflecting upon the Dominion Government and certain of its past and present members and officials. By way of illustrating the existence of political corruption, he charged the Department of the Interior with having ordered the police at Dawson City to refrain from interfering with the dancing halls; there out of respect for the men who held whiskey permits, cited cases of political appointments and of the construction of public works immediately before the election to influence, as he alleged, votes, referred to the charges of bribery against Speaker Macell at Bonaventure, and commented on the findings of the New Brunswick Commission affecting Hon. Mr. Pugsley and Lieut.-Governor Tweedie. He also made pointed allusions to the character of Mr. Emmerson and his opponent at the last election, and to Sir Frederick Borden, whom he stigmatized in terms that provoked murmurs of disapprobation. Incidentally he reproached the Assembly with having by its resolution last year "left him naked to his enemies," and mentioned that he had refused offers, presumably from the Tory party, to go on the stump before the election. At the close of his speech Dr. Pringle was warmly applauded by a section of the Assembly, but the end of the thirty-five Assembly was reached before the afternoon was well spent. Some surprise and not a little regret was expressed at the report of the Commissioner of the population of Home Mission Superintendent for Alberta, the reason advanced being that the remuneration, \$2,200, was not adequate.

Evils in Political Life.

The General Assembly decided to take active steps to prevent the party spirit from being allowed to influence the work of the Assembly.

Rev. Dr. James Robertson, a recommendation by the committee appointed to consider the matter that a sum of not less than \$20,000 be raised and the interest devoted to the support of a lectureship on missions in the colleges of the Church was adopted.

The recommendations of the Board of Moral and Social Reform were, on the motion of Mr. T. C. James, P.E.I., adopted.

Rev. Dr. Campbell did not think that in discussions in the Assembly on the white slave traffic the brutality of the male sex had been sufficiently emphasized. Men should be educated up to the proper standard, he said.

Rev. Dr. John Pringle moved the following amendment: "That the Assembly deplores and condemns the evils in our political life to-day, which are rapidly lowering the moral sense of our people, and urges upon its ministers and people the duty of earnestly and courageously combating the evils of our political life, wherever they may manifest themselves, and proclaiming the truth of God's word that righteousness exalts a nation and sin is a reproach to any people."

"These evils exist," declared Dr. Pringle, "unless all men are lars, and unless sinners on both sides of politics are edited by men who are writing what they know to be untrue."

Proceeding, he said he had been reproached by ministers and others for the letters that he had written and sent to the Assembly, and he said that he would not write any more.

It was then moved that the Assembly should go to Dawson and fight it out. As a result of the resolution passed at last year's Assembly, respecting the state of affairs in the Yukon, he had been left naked to his enemies. A month after the resolution

A Crown Attorney Who Waits.

The statute under which Mr. Seymour Corley, Crown Attorney for the city of Toronto, exercises his powers does not lend itself readily to his suggestion that some citizen who believes the Dufferin race track is operating under an obsolete charter may lay an information before he will move against it. Chapter 96 of the R.S.O., section 11, is very emphatic in laying the responsibility on him. Section 9 provides that the Crown Attorneys throughout the Province generally shall institute and conduct proceedings before the General Sessions only. The Crown Attorney for York and the Crown Attorney for the city of Toronto have wider powers. Section 11 says: "The Crown Attorney for the city of Toronto shall be the Crown Attorney whose duty it shall be to institute and conduct on behalf of the Crown prosecutions before the Police Magistrate for the city of Toronto, and to institute and conduct all other prosecutions in the Police Court of said city before the Police Magistrate, or any Justice acting for the Police Magistrate, under any act or law conferring summary power to convict for offences in relation to the public revenue, the public property, the public domain, the public health, the public peace, and other matters punishable on summary conviction before the Police Magistrate, and the said Crown Attorney is hereby empowered to institute such proceedings upon a complaint in writing or as public prosecutor in cases where the public interest requires the exercise of such office."

Mr. Corley's attention has been directed to the fact that an endeavor is being made to establish a race meeting at Dufferin Park on a dormant charter that, according to the statutes, should have been cancelled promptly last year when the track was opened. His attention has been directed to this indisputable fact, but he prefers "to wait" till the Woodbine cases have been disposed of. Mr. Corley swore to perform the duties set forth in the statute quoted above. Does he think his policy of waiting is a substantial compliance with his oath of office?

New York, June 10.—A murder similar to the notorious Goldenshoe case in the method of its execution and in the mystery which now surrounds it was presented to the police for solution this evening. Scores of detectives and policemen in plain clothes were hunting the lower East Side and the Bowery in search of a man of whom they have only the meagre description furnished by a sixteen-year-old boy.

This man was the last person, with the exception of the police and the boy, to have been in his possession two large packages done up in black oilcloth and brown paper, which were found the dismembered body of a man, the torso with head missing in one package and the severed legs and arms in the other. A fact which the police consider significant was the discovery upon each of the bundles of the words "Black Hand."

Joseph Tokoro, the young Italian boy, was the first to receive the parcels from the man, whose description he gave later to the police. A stranger, carrying one of the parcels over each shoulder, stopped opposite him and asked: "Do you want to earn five cents?"

Tokoro said he did, and the man asked him to carry one of the parcels. The lad said they looked too heavy, and he wouldn't try it.

Young Tokoro, accompanied the stranger until he came in front of the public school about fifty feet from Henry street. There the stranger stopped, and telling the boy to wait his return, started off in the direction of the East River.

Then he barked loudly and began running about the parcels, darting toward them and then jumping away as though he intended to snatch and rend them.
