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## 2008 BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE 2008 Civic Improvement Capital Projects

## **Issue:**

Report to Budget Committee on the details of the 2008 Civic Improvement Program's "A" and "B" lists for Places and Routes capital projects.

## **Background:**

Civic improvement projects arise out of opportunities to enhance on-going capital investments in the City's public realm, primarily its streets, parks, open spaces and public buildings. The projects typically include streetscape improvements (such as special paving, widened sidewalks, tree planting and landscaping), the creation of special features (such as plazas, fountains, gardens and interpretative displays) and naturalization programs.

Civic improvement streetscape projects are closely linked with the Transportation Services roadway and sidewalk annual capital works program, both by specific street location and timing of the city tendering cycle deadlines through the current budget year. A large number of potential streetscape projects meet the policy criteria adopted by Council. The selection of streetscape projects is heavily influenced by the opportunities presented by Transportation Services' capital program and the detailed project design criteria.

Transportation Services' capital program is often subject to project modifications, which arise due to a number of technical and scheduling reasons. Therefore, it is important for the Civic Improvement Program to maintain and include a "B list" of substitute projects and locations to allow the flexibility to quickly adjust to changes in Transportation Services' capital program.
