2008 BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE Transfer of Positions to PF&R and EDCT

Issue / Background:

As part of the Corporate Administrative Restructuring in 2005, the Administrative & Support Services Division (former EDCT Department) re-aligned to the Social Development, Finance & Administration (SDF&A) Division.

The Administrative & Support Services Division provided centralized administrative and program support in the areas of finance, payroll, communications, information technology, and customer service to the Parks, Forestry & Recreation (PF&R) Division and the Economic Development, Culture & Tourism (EDCT) Division.

As part of the SDF&A reorganization, the staffing resources providing direct operational support and services were transferred out of SDF&A to both PF&R and EDCT. This transfer occurred during 2006.

This was a direct transfer of existing positions and budget between divisions. The budget and positions were not replaced in SDF&A once transferred out (net zero corporately).
